Before founding Traveling Donors, Genevieve Uys was an egg donor herself.

Like many young women entering the fertility industry, she was motivated by the opportunity to help intended parents achieve their dream of having a family.

What she did not expect was the lack of support, communication, and compassion she would experience along the way.

As a donor, Genevieve participated in donation programs both locally and internationally.

While she witnessed the incredible joy that donor conception could bring to intended parents, she also saw another side of the industry.

A side that rarely appeared in brochures or agency marketing.

A side where donors often felt overlooked, unsupported, and treated as part of a process rather than as individuals.

Those experiences would ultimately change the course of her life.

The Experience That Changed Everything

One particular international donation journey would leave a lasting impression.

Genevieve travelled to Mumbai, India as part of an egg donation program involving approximately twenty young women.

While the medical procedures were carried out, something was missing.

Compassion.

Communication.

Emotional support.

Individual care.

Many of the women felt isolated throughout the process.

Questions often went unanswered.

Concerns were dismissed.

Emotional wellbeing was rarely addressed.

Instead of feeling valued as people helping to create families, many felt like participants in a system focused solely on outcomes.

For Genevieve, this experience raised an important question:

Surely there had to be a better way.

Searching For Something Different

Following her return home, Genevieve began researching fertility agencies around the world.

She searched for an organization that placed equal value on intended parents, donors, and surrogates.

An agency built around:

The more she searched, the more she realised something surprising.

The agency she was looking for did not exist.

The Birth Of Traveling Donors

On the evening of 11 December 2011, sitting alone in her hotel room in Mumbai at the end of a donation cycle, Genevieve made a decision that would ultimately change thousands of lives.

She opened her laptop.

Created a website.

And began building what would become Traveling Donors.

It started with a simple idea.

Create the agency she wished had existed when she was a donor.

Create the experience she wished she had received.

Create a company that remembered the humanity behind every fertility journey.

That evening became the foundation of what would grow into an internationally recognised fertility coordination agency.

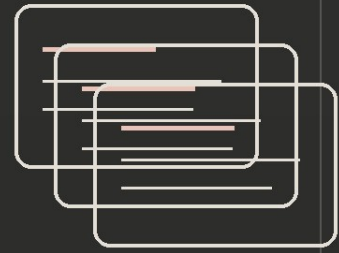

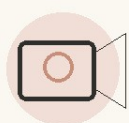

WAIS-5 testing can be arranged on request, subject to qualified professional administration, local availability and donor consent.

An additional assessment—not a guarantee of treatment outcome or child characteristics.

UNDERSTANDING DONOR-EGG TREATMENT



A pathway when another route may not be possible.

A fertility specialist may discuss donor eggs when a person's own eggs are unavailable, unsuitable or unlikely to result in pregnancy.

**Ovarian function**

No usable eggs are being produced, or ovarian reserve is significantly reduced.

**Egg quality**

Previous treatment suggests a poor response or eggs unlikely to support pregnancy.

**Genetic risk**

There is a significant risk of passing on an inherited condition.

**Treatment history**

Chemotherapy, surgery or illness has affected ovarian function.

**Early menopause**

Premature ovarian insufficiency or early menopause has been diagnosed.

**Family pathway**

A single parent or same-sex male couple requires donor eggs, often alongside surrogacy.

The decision begins with a medical consultation - not a donor profile.

Your fertility specialist determines whether donor-egg treatment is appropriate for you.

General information only. Individual diagnosis and treatment decisions belong to the treating medical team.

DONOR IDENTITY & FUTURE CONTACT

The words differ. The questions matter.



Terminology and information rights differ between countries, clinics and donor programmes.

01

Directed / identified

Often called a 'known donor'. The donor and intended parents know one another's identities. Contact and relationship expectations should be discussed, counselled and documented.

02

Identity-release

Identifying information may become available to the donor-conceived person at a legally defined age or through a registry, depending on the jurisdiction and programme.

03

Nonidentified

Identities are not routinely exchanged within the programme. Laws, registries and consumer DNA databases mean permanent anonymity cannot be assumed.

WHAT GOVERNS THE ARRANGEMENT

The clinic, donor registry, written agreement and applicable law determine access to information, future contact and legal parentage. Independent legal advice is essential for directed arrangements and international treatment.

Not every pathway is available in every destination. Confirm the rules before selecting a programme.

Exact panels and testing requirements remain clinic-, laboratory- and destination-specific, and the treating medical team makes the final clearance decision.

Once intended parents select a donor and her availability is reconfirmed, the Egg Donor Reservation Agreement is the first contract signed and the applicable reservation payment is made. This allows testing to begin.

Depending on program requirements, this stage may involve:

- Egg Donor Reservation Agreement & Payment
- Donor + Sperm-Source Genetic Screening
- Genetic Compatibility Confirmation
- Fertility & Medical Screening
- Psychological Assessment Where Required
- Final Clinic Clearance

Genetic results generally take about 3-4 weeks. Only after compatibility and the required medical clearance are confirmed does the case move to the main donor contract and active cycle planning.

STEP 5

Program Planning

After genetic compatibility and medical approval are confirmed, the main Egg Donor Agreement is signed. The remaining invoice balance must be funded into SeedTrust escrow 30 days before the donor begins stimulation, after which the final cycle plan is activated.

This stage may include:

- Treatment Scheduling
- Donor Coordination
- Medication Planning
- Documentation Preparation
- Fertility Clinic Coordination
- Travel Planning
- Timeline Development

This phase transforms a fertility plan into an actionable journey.

BEFORE THE CYCLE

Intended-parent readiness.

Clear medical, genetic, legal, financial and travel planning allows the programme to move efficiently once the donor is selected.



● Clinic plan

Written treatment pathway and recipient or embryo plan from the treating clinic.

● Genetic carrier screen

Every intended father whose sperm will be used - or sperm donor/provider - completes the required screen so compatibility with the donor can be confirmed.

● Recipient medical review

Medical history, uterine assessment and laboratory testing as directed by the treating clinic.

● Sperm-source plan

Fresh, frozen or shipped sample arrangements, semen analysis and clinic documentation where applicable.

● Documents

Passports, identity, address, consent and destination-specific legal or clinic forms.

Selection reconfirmed

Traveling Donors confirms that the donor remains interested and available for the proposed programme.

2

Egg Donor Reservation Agreement

This is the first contract signed. The applicable reservation payment is made so donor testing can begin.

3

Genetic testing - first

Donor plus intended father/sperm provider complete carrier screening. Results generally take about 3-4 weeks.

4

Genetic match confirmed

Compatibility is reviewed before fertility testing and medical clearance continue.

5

Fertility & medical clearance

Clinic-directed hormone testing, ultrasound, infectious screening and other required assessments are completed.

6

Main Egg Donor Agreement

Once approved and genetically matched, the main donor contract is signed.

7

SeedTrust funding

The remaining invoice balance is funded into escrow 30 days before the donor starts stimulation.

8

Cycle plan activated

Clinic schedule, medication, monitoring, travel and retrieval arrangements are finalised.

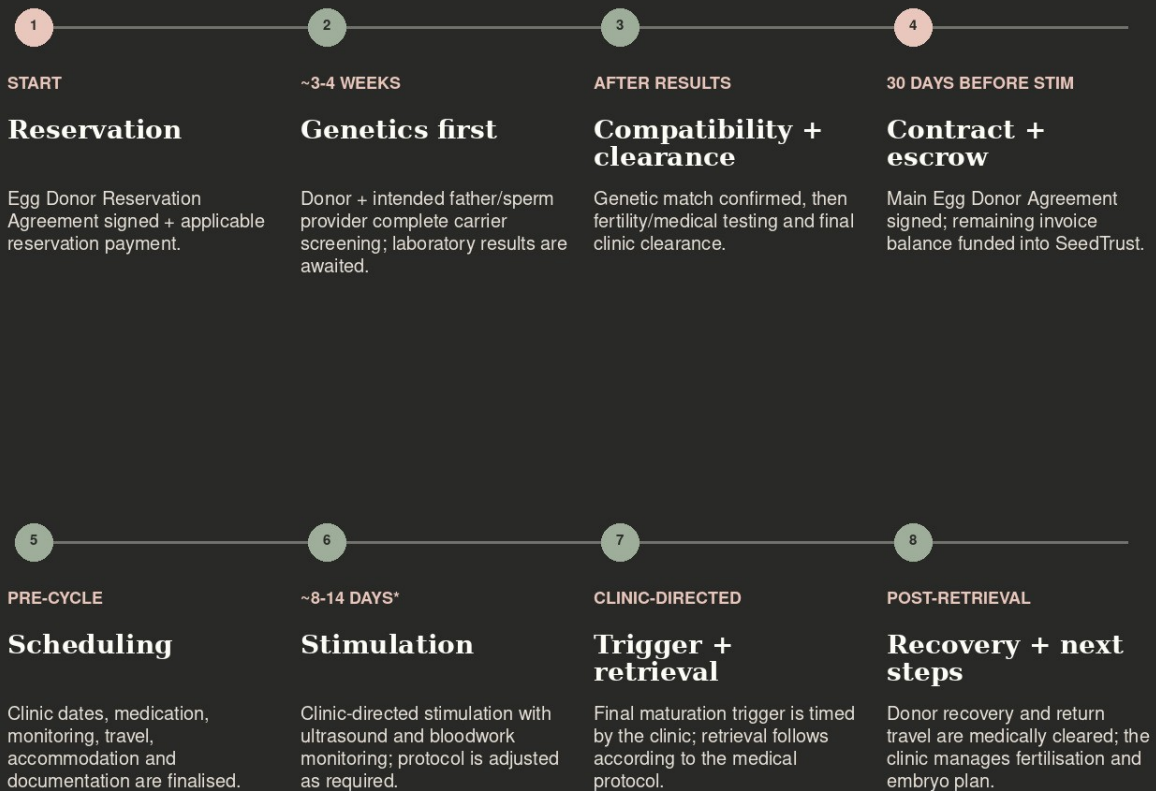
Selected is not reserved. Reserved is not medically cleared. Cleared is not yet funded for stimulation.

The signed reservation agreement, main donor agreement, personalised quote and treating clinic requirements govern each case.

EXAMPLE EGG DONOR CYCLE TIMELINE

How quickly can a cycle begin?

Testing can start as soon as the reservation agreement is signed and paid. Active stimulation follows only after genetics, medical clearance, contracts and escrow funding.



The fastest safe start is the one in which every clearance, agreement and funding milestone is complete - not a fixed calendar promise.

*Stimulation duration is illustrative; actual timing is set by the treating clinic and may vary by donor response and protocol.

FRESH EGG DONATION TODAY

Individual by default. Group cycles remain possible.

Traveling Donors now completes most fresh donations as individual cycles, while retaining the option of coordinated group donations when appropriate.



CURRENT STANDARD

Individual donor cycle

One selected donor follows a cycle built around her medical clearance, clinic protocol, intended-parent plan and travel schedule.

STILL POSSIBLE

Group donation cycle

Selected donors may travel in a coordinated group when donor availability, clinic capacity, treatment dates and programme needs align. It is an option, not the routine model.

THE CLINICAL PATHWAY

1

Baseline & plan

Clinic confirms clearance, dates and protocol.

2

Stimulation

Medication begins under clinic direction.

3

Monitoring

Ultrasound and bloodwork guide treatment.

4

Trigger & retrieval

Final maturation and retrieval are clinic-timed.

5

Fertilisation / embryo plan

Lab fertilises eggs; transfer, testing, freezing or shipping follows the agreed plan.

6

Recovery & follow-up

Donor recovery and return travel are medically cleared; the clinic directs all follow-up.

No two cycles follow the same schedule. The treating clinic's written medical protocol always governs.

Programme format depends on donor, clinic, destination, treatment dates and written case terms.

If a donor does not want to travel alone, donor + companion flights are paid directly to our travel agent via an online payment link. The link may be paid by credit or debit card. Flight cost is therefore not included in the illustrative total above.

A transparent programme quote distinguishes agency coordination from medical and other third-party costs.

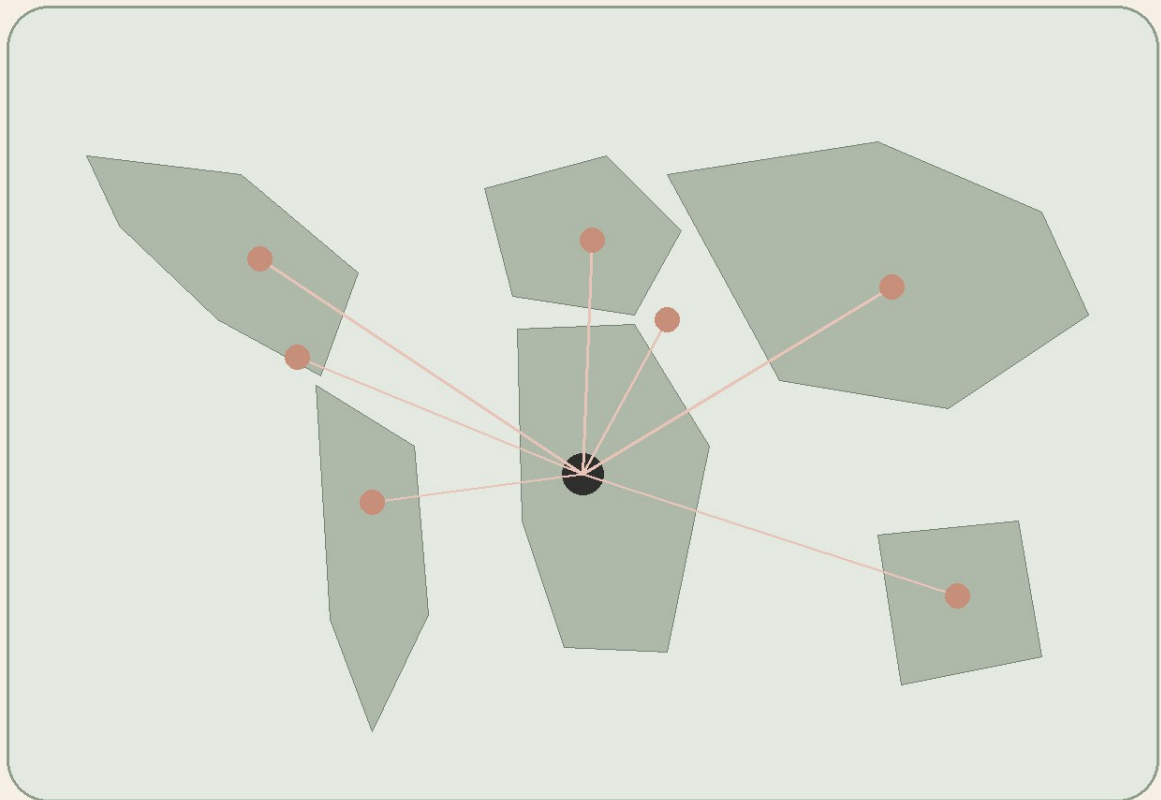

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Clear answers before you begin.

The practical questions families ask most often - written for today's global Traveling Donors programmes.



How long does donor matching take?

It can take from around two weeks to several months. Timing depends on the characteristics requested, donor availability and the intended parents' choice. Traveling Donors contacts the donor when there is a potential match.

How soon can testing and a cycle begin?

Testing can begin after the Egg Donor Reservation Agreement is signed and the applicable reservation payment is made. Genetics generally takes about 3-4 weeks; stimulation only follows genetic compatibility, medical clearance, the main donor contract and SeedTrust funding.

How will we meet or speak with our egg donor?

Video introductions are available on request, and Traveling Donors can coordinate donor/IP Zoom calls. In-person introductions may also be possible where the programme, timing and mutual consent allow.

Do we need to spend time with the donor?

No. Contact is voluntary. The donor and intended parents can agree on what feels comfortable, subject to the identity model, clinic or legal requirements and each person's boundaries.

How is genetic carrier screening handled?

Genetic testing is done first. The selected donor and every intended father whose sperm will be used - or sperm donor/provider - complete the required screening so genetic compatibility can be confirmed before the programme progresses.

Are donors medically screened?

Yes. The TD file includes detailed medical and family history, followed by clinic-directed fertility and medical screening. Exact tests vary by clinic, destination and donor history.

Are donors screened for cystic fibrosis?

Carrier screening is no longer treated as a single-disease question. The clinic or laboratory selects the appropriate panel for the donor and sperm source, and compatibility is reviewed before proceeding.

What does WAIS-5 testing mean?

WAIS-5 IQ testing can be arranged as an additional assessment when requested, professionally appropriate, locally available and consented to by the donor. It is not a substitute for medical or genetic screening.

For individual medical, genetic, legal and treatment advice, follow the professionals appointed to your case.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Treatment, fees & expectations.

Global guidance replaces location-specific clinic instructions. The treating clinic and signed programme documents always govern.

**Are there restrictions during stimulation?**

Donors must follow the treating clinic's written instructions, including any restrictions concerning smoking or vaping, alcohol, medication, supplements, exercise, sexual activity or travel. Requirements vary by protocol.

Can two embryos be transferred?

The number of embryos transferred is a medical and regulatory decision for the treating clinic and intended parents, subject to the destination's law and the patient's clinical circumstances. Traveling Donors does not make that decision.

How are programme fees structured?

IPs receive a personalised written quote based on the selected donor, her compensation request, treatment country, travel requirements and third-party services. The quote and signed agreements state payment milestones and exclusions.

Why is SeedTrust escrow used?

Escrow provides a neutral third-party process for case funds, clearer payment records and reduced uncertainty for the donor, intended parents and agency. The remaining invoice balance is funded 30 days before stimulation under the current TD process.

Can we speak with previous intended parents?

Testimonials or references may be shared only when a previous client has expressly agreed and subject to availability. Privacy comes first.

How experienced is Traveling Donors?

Traveling Donors was founded in 2011 and has 15+ years of international fertility experience, with access to a global network and more than 3,000 donor profiles.

What success rate can we expect?

Success rates are clinic- and case-specific and change over time. Ask the treating clinic for its current verified data relevant to your treatment type. No agency or donor can guarantee a pregnancy or live birth.

Do you support international and diverse families?

Yes. Traveling Donors supports international intended parents, same-sex couples and other family structures, with fresh and frozen donor pathways depending on the programme, clinic and destination.

For individual medical, genetic, legal and treatment advice, follow the professionals appointed to your case.
